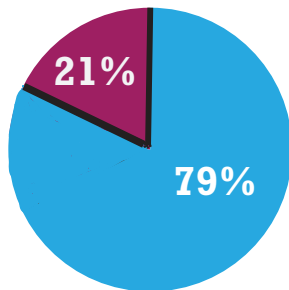
Our Mission

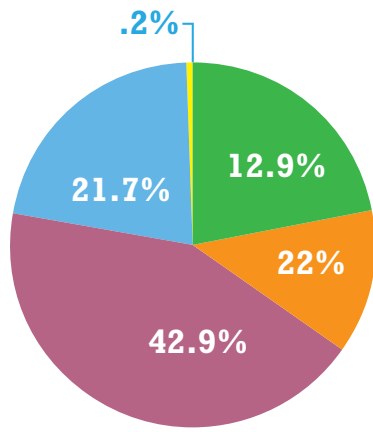

Number of School Groups by County

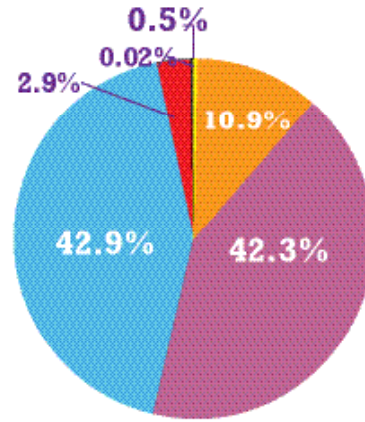
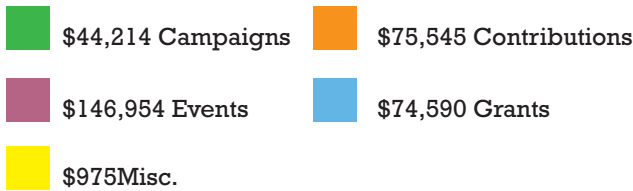

Number of Students Served by County

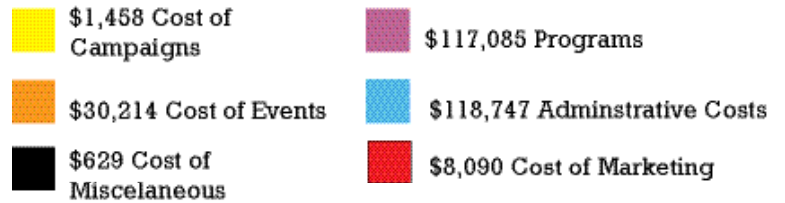
